





AISCLI SUMMER SCHOOL: WORLD CULTURES AND LITERATURES IN ENGLISH

September 18 - 20, 2017 - University of Torino, Italy

DESCRIPTION The AISCLI Summer School provides a full immersion course aiming at widening the competence of BA students (also those who wish to become teachers, educators, cultural mediators, translators) in the field of postcolonial theories, literatures and cultures, to help them direct their future academic choices and theses. Postdocs, senior post-graduate students, doctoral students, PhD holders and High-School teachers are also encouraged to apply. This wider perspective as applied to African, Caribbean, Canadian, Pacific and Asian artistic and intellectual productions will be the focus of workshops held by International and Italian academics.

ATTENDERS BA graduate students with a Degree in the Humanities, PhD holders, PhD students and PhD candidates, postdocs and senior post-graduate students, Faculty, High-School Teachers and Free-lance and independent scholars are welcome, too. The Summer School will be activated with a minimum of 15 participants.

LOCATION All the lectures and seminars will be at Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures and Modern Cultures – University of Torino (I) Room: Sala Lauree - Via Verdi 10, II floor.

CERTIFICATION At the end of the AISCLI Summer School participants will be given a Certificate of Attendance.

150 € for all afternoon sessions or 3 sessions, either mornings or afternoons (3 CFU)




